### What Will Happen?

EYFS and KS1 children will take part in our new carousel-style Sports Day, rotating around a variety of fun activities before finishing with a selection of races. Each crew contains a mixture of Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, encouraging teamwork and support across the year groups. Following the carousel, all children will compete in a range of running races. KS2 children will be taking part in a carousel of field events followed by a reduced number of races as chosen by the children. All children will take part in the field events and they have selected the races that they want to do.

### Important Information

- Please could you ensure that:
- Children arrive wearing sun cream if the weather is warm. Please also send additional sun cream in their bag if they are able to re-apply it independently at lunchtime.
- Children wear a sun hat
- Every child brings a named water bottle
- Children wear their full PE kit together with their correct crew colour
- We are happy for parents and carers to take photographs of **their own child** during Sports Day. We kindly ask that these photographs are **not shared online**, in line with our safeguarding policy.
- Parents and carers are warmly invited to attend. To help the morning run smoothly, we kindly ask that spectators remain within the designated viewing area throughout the event.
- Please do not move around the field whilst activities are taking place as this can unsettle our children.
- We encourage spectators to bring a picnic blanket or folding chair for your comfort – chairs will not be put out like in previous years.
- Smoking, vaping and the consumption of alcohol are not permitted anywhere on the school site during Sports Day. Thank you for helping us maintain a safe and healthy environment for all children.
