

This week Year 6 visited Life skills at the Create Centre in Bristol. Lifeskills have created a fantastic realistic village which enabled our year 6 pupils to learn how to deal with difficult and potentially dangerous situations, in a safe and supportive environment. The year 6's learnt about road and railway safety, how to deal with hazardous scenes set up in kitchens, living rooms and at a substation. They also learnt some basic first aid and practiced making emergency phone calls. The children really enjoyed the experience with brilliantly staged learning activities set up by Life Skills.


