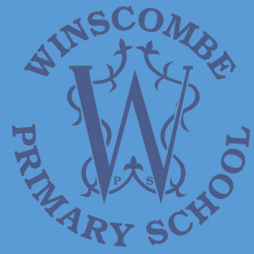

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Online Safety Advice - YouTube

We know that many of our pupils enjoy watching and searching video clips on YouTube. However, without the correct controls in place, they could soon end up watching something very different from the clip they started viewing.

Youtube for kids can be downloaded from the app store. It was created especially for children under 13 years of age, using stronger filtering to keep children safe. It is important to remember that nothing is 100% safe so keep checking in with what they are doing and have those important safety chats.


