It is really important to chat with your children on an ongoing basis about staying safe online. Knowing what they are learning about in their online safety lessons could be a great place to begin.

Our Online Safety focus for the spring term is 'I am Safe and Secure'.

Below, you will find the focus for each year group and ideas for discussion at home.

Walnut and Oak Classes have been discussing the importance of sharing with an adult what they are doing online. They have talked about asking an adult before they go online and checking that an adult can see what they are doing.

Look at the 'Building Habits When I Use Technology' poster with your child and discuss what they like to do when they are online.

Linden Class have been thinking about how they can keep their personal information safe when they're online.

Ask your child what they know about keeping themselves safe online.

Ash Class have been discussing how information they share online will stay there to be seen and used by others. They have been thinking about how they can make safe choices when using technology to communicate responsibly with others
